Our 39th season includes three brand new productions for NMYA and one classic reprise.

In November of 2018, NMYA will present the musical **The Secret Garden**. Mary Lennox, the newest resident at Misselthwaite Manor, helps to bring a neglected garden back to life and in doing so, magically restores the health of her sickly cousin, Colin. The musical is based on the classic novel by Frances Hodgson Burnett and is filled with memorable tunes from Bill Francoeur and Tim Kelly. At the KiMo Theatre, November 6—11.

Our fall 2018 play will be **Legend of Sleepy Hollow** by Vera Morris, based on the classic story by Washington Irving. When the new school master, Ichabod Crane, arrives in the Dutch village of Sleepy Hollow and sets his eyes on Katrina Van Tassel, he presents a challenge to local troublemaker, Brom Bones. Crane must get lost if Miss Van Tassel is to remain Brom's girlfriend! Funny, exciting, and just a little scary, this play is great for all ages. On tour November 26—December 4 and at the North 4th Theater on December 1.

Continuing our tradition of spring Broadway classics, NMYA will present the Disney favorite, **Beauty and the Beast, Jr.**, in April of 2019. Based on the 1991 animated film and the French fairy tale, this popular musical follows Belle and her relationship with the hideous Beast, who has imprisoned her in his castle. Only after getting to know the true heart of the Beast does Belle fall in love with him and break the decades-long curse on the castle and its peculiar inhabitants. This musical was a huge hit when last performed by NMYA in 2011. Performance Dates: April 9—14 at the KiMo Theatre.

The last production of our 2018-2019 season will be a charming play by Edith Weiss, **The Frog Prince of Spamalot**. Hyronomous A. Frog doesn't fit in anywhere. After learning that he used to be a handsome prince, he goes on a quest to get a kiss from a beautiful maiden in order to break the curse that turned him into a frog. Hilarity ensues as he finds his way to the castle of Princess Gladiola and tries to learn to walk and eat with proper etiquette. On tour April 29—May 7 and at the North Fourth Theater, May 4.
